## Rules and Expectations for John Bapst Memorial High School Dances

- 1. Dances will take place from 7:30 p.m. 10:30 p.m. Students must be admitted to the dance within the first hour. All guests must arrive with the John Bapst student who is responsible for them.
- 2. All students are expected to leave the building promptly at 10:30 p.m. Chaperones are not expected or required to stay past 10:30 p.m.
- 3. If a student leaves the building, he/she/they will not be readmitted to the dance.
- 4. All students must enter and exit through the foyer door.
- 5. Proper attire is required; clothing should allow for freedom of movement without excessive exposure. Chaperones will determine if attire is not appropriate and will ask students to change if necessary.
- 6. No containers, cups, water bottles, food etc. may be brought into the building.
- 7. Students are allowed to be in the foyer, auditorium, and first floor hallway (to the boys bathroom and to the water fountain across from the main office). Students may not use the stairwells going up from the foyer to the first floor and are not allowed to go to their lockers or other places in the school building.
- 8. Drug, alcohol, and nicotine products and associated paraphernalia are strictly forbidden. Chaperones will call the parents of any student whom they suspect has used or possesses any of these substances and ask them to come pick up their student.
- 9. Everyone in attendance is expected to dance in an appropriate manner. Dancers must face each other and any dancing which is considered to be obscene is prohibited.
- 10. Chaperones have the right and reponsibility to remove students and their guests from dances for failure to adhere to the established expectations.
