DISTINGUISHED GRADUATES PROGRAM

Students have many options to pursue their passions in four areas of in-depth study: Fine Arts, Global Studies, Humanities, and STEM. In addition to completing a concentration of courses, students also work with a mentor to design and complete a project that they present in a public forum. It is also possible to custom-design an individualized program.

OUTSTANDING STEM PROGRAM

The STEM fields – science, technology, engineering, and mathematics – are the basis for many of the world's most important innovations. Every John Bapst student receives a strong math-science foundation.

HUMANITIES

In English, students study classic and contemporary works in AP, Honors, and regular sections. AP Human Geography, World History, American History, Economics, Psychology, World Cultures, and Political Science ready students for the wider world around them. 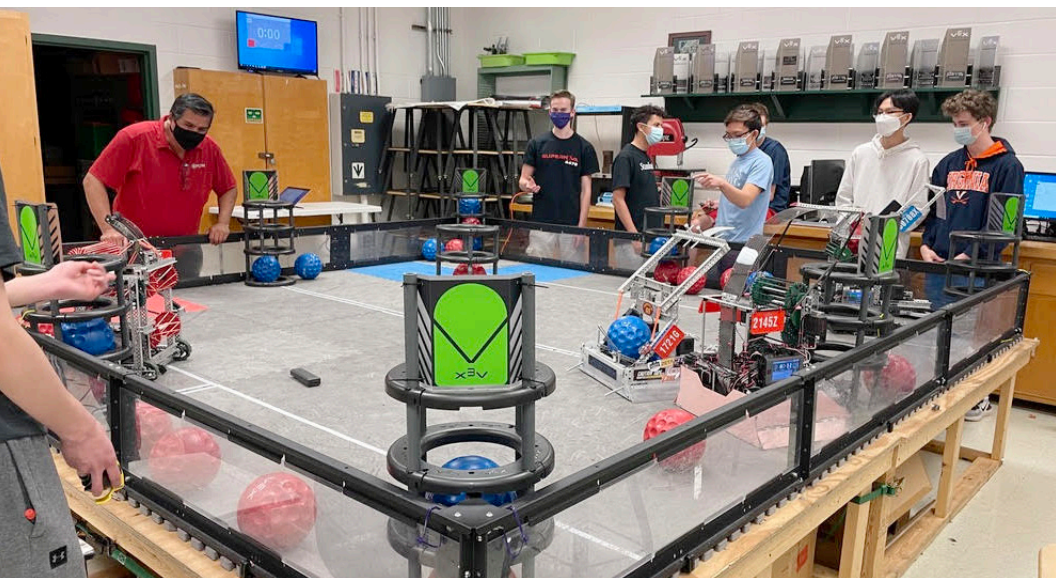
