

Pandemic and Perseverance

first came to John Bapst for a job interview in 2006. My wife had taken a job as a professor at UMaine and I came to interview for a position as a history teacher. I loved this school from the first moment I walked in. After meeting staff and doing some practice teaching with kids, I phoned my wife and said "I think I've found teacher heaven!" I realized quickly what a special place this is. I was fortunate to be offered that teacher job and then two years later to be offered the academic dean position. Now, in my first year as head of school, and in my 31st year in education, I love it even more than when I arrived.

To say that it's been a difficult couple of years would be an understatement. The pandemic upended everything we know and love about schools and teaching. For the first time in anyone's memory, we were supposed to avoid being close to kids. It has felt like the worst kind of crisis. Yet the history teacher in me knows that this school was built one year before the Great Depression, it survived that depression, a world war, a cold war, civil unrest in the 60s and 70s, and a near closure in 1980. John Bapst has weathered too many crises to be stopped by a virus.

John Bapst has persevered. When the school had to close, we moved education online (within two days!) and kept teaching. When the pandemic surged in 2020, we moved to hybrid mode so we could have as many kids as possible in person. We adjusted sports and clubs, made changes to our traditions, and kept serving students and families. It is remarkable that several of our international students arrived in Bangor as

sophomores and will not see their families until they are John Bapst graduates. Talk about perserverance!

The pandemic may have won the shocking first round in the spring of 2020. The second round, the next year, was even harder, but we stayed on our feet. Hybrid teaching was hard and unfamiliar. The pandemic struck directly at the teacher-student relationship that is at the center of our work. But we found ways to adjust and connect and kept at it. That difficult year ended on a high note – an in-person graduation, prom and Class Night.

In this school year, the tide is turning in our favor. We began the year determined to restore all those things we missed. We have all our kids and teachers in school. Our fall teams were in the playoffs. We may be wearing masks, but we have assemblies and dances again. We have confronted the pandemic, learned from it, adapted, and now have found ways to thrive in spite of it. Two classes of students have now graduated and gone on to colleges during this pandemic. We have opened our first new building in 93 years. Determined to not miss another homecoming together, we held a pep rally on the sidewalk and restored the tradition of a parade to the football game from the school to Cameron Stadium. Covid-19 has not slowed down this wonderful school.

The pandemic is still with us. But we are formidable. The John Bapst community is as smart, creative, and resilient as ever. Despite the challenges the coronavirus has placed before us, we are still optimistic. We are not just surviving, we are looking toward the future with optimism and confidence. This community has survived so many crises and will survive this one. We've got this!



WE WERE BACK TOGETHER

ike so many things in the pandemic, graduation was a little different in 2021. We were committed to finding a way for the senior class to graduate together in the same place, at the same time. Students in 2020 missed out on a full graduation and we were absolutely dedicated to finding a better way for 2021. Schools nationwide faced the same dilemma. The absence of a campus meant that we were looking for other venues for graduation events. Dave Armistead met frequently with principals of local public schools to discuss ideas and find ways to share resources.

These connections with local schools were very important to us. When Hermon High School offered to share their space and their resources for us to host graduation there, we accepted. So, on June 6, 2021, John Bapst took over the Hermon High School football field. We covered the Hermon banner on the fence with our own (saved from the previous year's graduation!). We had a sea of purple gowns and a professional sound and video system in place. It rained all around Hermon, but not on John Bapst. It was a beautiful afternoon. We may not have been at 100 Broadway, but we were together!

Returning to Normal: Thoughts From Our Academic Dean

n a recent walk around the building about an hour after classes had ended for the day, I heard excited chatter coming from the biology lab and found a couple dozen kids carefully peering down at trays of cow eyeballs. The science department was offering an enrichment dissection lab for members of the school's new science club, a student initiative proposed to me over the summer by seniors Jacob Levesque and Caleb Canders. It was for me a moment to reflect on just how much teachers and students appreciate being back to teaching and learning in person at 100 Broadway. The 2020-21 school year was one of the hardest and most disruptive years we'll endure in education, and, while the pandemic continues to affect us, the creation of our new "normal" is ongoing.

To maintain in-person teaching and learning this year, John Bapst initially adopted universal indoor masking and physical distancing in classrooms; however, with the virus continuing to spread in the wider community this fall, we added seating charts (for better contact tracing) and pooled testing to expand the layers of protection, further limiting disruptions to teaching and learning. Though it's different at 100 Broadway these days, we're continuing to find ways to make the school experience feel like it once did – we held our annual homecoming activities in October, including an outdoor pep rally, we hosted the annual fall Red Cross blood drive in November, and in early December we had our first dance in nearly two years!

Like everywhere on campus, students in Mrs. O'Connell's chemistry class wear masks as they get their work done. Students and teachers alike have adapted to what is the new normal, including universal masking, seating charts, and pooled testing.

n Friday, October 8, and as part of the school's Homecoming celebrations, John Bapst hosted a special guest (with his family) for a special occasion. Dr. Reginald P. McManus '48 and members of his family were present for the dedication of the girls' dorm at 80 Broadway as the Kathleen Flanagan McManus '48 House.

The gift Dr. McManus and his family made will help ensure that the school's commitment of instilling a sense of determination and growth in its students will continue well into the future.

"Determination," in fact, is the word assigned to a portrait of a young Kathleen now hanging in the front hall of the dormitory, along with a plaque marking the dedication.

Generosity, commitment, and determination are nothing new for Dr. McManus and his family. He visits us often from his home in Virginia and has been a supporter of the school, support that includes a longstanding scholarship for John Bapst students going on to attend Bowdoin College, his alma mater.

Son Chris addressed a group including other family members, boarding students, and administrators: "For our parents, educating their five children was always important. They instilled in us the value of a liberal arts education in order that we would become what they call 'well-rounded adults' ... lovers of






knowledge and truth. Education to them was all about seeking and trying to understand and know the 'higher' more important things."

Growing up in Bangor in the 1940s Kathleen Flanagan grew up on Maple Street while Reginald grew up on the other side of the city, on Lincoln Street. They met at a middle school dance in 1944 and attended John Bapst together, in an environment where boys were on one side of the building, girls on the other. They graduated together in 1948.

Reginald and Kathleen went on to build a happy life together, he became a doctor, she a nurse. They raised five children, and instilled what they believed to be life's most important message.

In speaking to the students, Chris closed with that message: "It is necessary for you to know what is truly right and just. It is necessary that you gain wisdom so you know the truth. It is essential for you to become well-rounded adults. It's necessary that you develop the tools necessary to distinguish what is truly good. You need a proper education in critical thinking to achieve these ends. It is most important that at the end of the day you chase perfection.

"I challenge you to realize that for real perfection, however, you

must go beyond. Even more important is that you inspire those in your life to seek the same goal – in whatever capacity they can. You need to bring others along to that goal to see and realize the joy and wonder of the common good. To bring to others knowledge and understanding of what is truly good – that is a purposeful life.

"So, we all have hope that everyone educated here at John Bapst pursues that goal. That is my father's and mother's wish with this memorial.

"And most of all – be good."

With a ribbon-cutting ceremony at the new Mary Ellen and Edward Darling Athletic Center, John Bapst launched an era of new opportunities in athletics, fitness, and friendships.

he culmination of John Bapst's campaign to build an on-campus practice gym and fitness center took place under sunny skies Wednesday, May 26 at 11 a.m. as Mary Ellen '59 and Edward Darling cut the ribbon on the new Mary Ellen and Edward Darling Athletic Center. Mr. and Mrs. Darling are proud John Bapst parents and grandparents.

Made possible by the "Love That School!" capital campaign under the guidance of former Head of School Mel MacKay, the 14,000 square foot, \$3.8 million facility at 28 Somerset Street in Bangor in now fully operational and being enjoyed by students and faculty.

The athletic center was designed by Mike Pullen of Artifex Architects and Engineers and built by Nickerson & O'Day, whose CEO, Karl Ward, and wife Dr. Kathy Ward are parents of three John Bapst graduates.

Also acknowledged at the celebration were the building partners involved and the many donors whose generosity made this addition to the John Bapst campus possible. The school now has a facility that reflects its goal of instilling the attributes of health and fitness in students today and in the future.

Especially notable were golfers Charlotte Blanchard '24, Travis True '22, and Justin Solomon '22 who each competed in the state tournament. For the first time since 2016, the mens soccer team qualified for the postseason as the #4 seed in Northern Maine and won three playoff games on the way to a regional championship game.

Having played competitive chess since 5th grade, **Benjamin Mock '22 recently finished in 1st place in "Class B"** of the Denker National Tournament of High School Chess Champions in New Jersey. Alumni Accolade

John Bapst graduate, parent and Penobscot Nation tribal ambassador **Maulian Dana '02** has been receiving international acclaim for her documentary, the Upstander Project's film **'Bounty'**. The film confronts the governmentissued scalp bounties against the Wabanaki peoples, men, women,

and children, in a region called the Dawnland, from 1675 to 1769. It's a little-known chapter of colonial-era history, and to make the film, co-directors Maulian Dana and Dawn Neptune Adams took their children and other family members to Boston's Old State House to read the death warrant that was issued for their Penobscot ancestors in 1755.
Their research has found that there were nearly 70 government-issued bounties for Indigenous people in what is now New England. View the film at bountyfilm.org.
