



Parent Affidavit of Support and Proof of Financial Capability



In addition to providing the information requested on this form, please submit the documents listed in #1 and #2 below. Documents must be photocopies or faxes, current (less than three months old). Completion of this form means you are swearing to the United States government that you will provide a specific amount of money from your own financial resources for every year your child will study and live in the US.

- 1. Proof of income (any one of the following)
 - a. Income tax returns or receipts with most recent pay stub
 - b. Pay stubs for the last six months
 - c. Bank/investment statements for the last six months
- 2. Bank statement in supporter's name only. *This statement must include monthly statement of balances and deposits*.
